Deloitte has been appointed by CEWA to help with the transition of the Santa Clara Parent and Friends Association to the Santa Clara School Parent and Friends Committee. We confirm acceptance that Deloitte can act on our behalf. This becomes effective this evening, Tuesday, 22nd November 2022.

After our Welcome Picnic scheduled for Term 1 was cancelled due to Covid, we moved onto our first fundraiser of the year, our annual Easter raffle, which is always such a great success. Thank you to our school community for the many donations of chocolates that were received, resulting in lots of prizes for each class.
