### FEDERAL FUNDING FOR SCHOOLS

Over the past few months, there has been a lot of information in the media

Turnbull Government's about the Quality Schools funding package and its impact on Catholic school fees.

3 August 2017

The package proposed by the Government is a 10-year funding model, which will see significant changes to how Catholic schools are funded in the future. Like the majority of Catholic schools, our school aims to be open and accessible to all families seeking a Catholic education.

Executive Director, Dr McDonald, has assured families, in a letter sent to all parents, via our school, **CEWA** (Catholic Education that Western Australia) will continue to maintain a laser focus on affordability, to ensure accessibility for every family seeking a Catholic education.

CEWA's current federal funding arrangements will remain in place for 2018. The next 12 months will also provide CEWA, as a system, with the time to consider how the additional funding, provided by the Federal Government, will be distributed across the system, meeting the needs of our students.

#### **ANAPHYLAXIS**

You would have read the headlines and seen the news stories: food allergies are growing concern in schools across Australia. Millions of children – children who are perfectly healthy and normal in every other way – must watch every single bite they eat or risk suffering a severe or even life threatening reaction. In fact, food allergies claim over 200 lives and are responsible for over 30,000 emergency room visits each year. A major health issue such as this one needs to be taken seriously, and it has always been the policy of our school to make the safety and well being of our students our top priority. Several children in this school have food allergies.

As part of our Christian community, Santa Clara School extends support to these children and their families. Each child with this allergy has an Emergency Action Plan, which has been formulated in cooperation with the parents and medical professionals because of the seriousness of the possible reactions.

# THE BISHOPS' RELIGIOUS LITERACY ASSESSMENT 2017

At the request of the Western Australian Bishops, Year 3, Year 5 and Year 9 students in Catholic schools across Western Australia will take part in *The Bishops' Religious Literacy Assessment* (BRLA) from the week commencing next **Monday 7 August 2017**. The assessment will be accessible to students only online.

Students enrolled in Year 3, Year 5 and Year 9 who are following a regular classroom program are expected to participate. Students with disability are also entitled to participate in the assessment. Exemptions may apply.

#### The Nature and Role of the BRLA

The Bishops' Religious Literacy Assessment is a large-scale, standardised assessment program that consists of a series of Religious Education (RE) assessments. The purpose of the BRLA is to measure student learning of the content in the RE curriculum. The test items in the BRLA are developed and mostly marked by the Office of Catholic Education Western Australia (CEWA). Formal school and student reports are produced by the CEWA for students in Year 5 and Year 9.

The BRLA provides a 'point in time' snapshot of student performance in RE. Students' knowledge and understanding of the content of the RE curriculum is assessed using a combination of multiple choice, short and extended response items. Students' faith is not assessed. The use of the BRLA complements the school based assessment programs in RE.

Wednesday 9 August 2017 - 10:50am to 12:50pm BRLA Assessment (Year 5)

Wednesday 16 August 2017 – 8:40am to 10:50am BRLA Assessment (Year 3)



### **New Tracksuits for 2018**

#### Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you that, in 2018, the present windcheaters and tracksuit pants will be replaced with a new Micro fibre jacket and tracksuit pants.

This change has come about due to several requests from parents and, after many a discussion with Mr Win Pe, Leadership Team and School Board, it was decided that a change to the tracksuit was long overdue.

The new track top and pants have many great features. They are made from Micro fibre with a jersey lining. The jacket has a full zip front, two zippered pockets and elasticated cuffs with adjustable flap. The pants are also jersey lined to the knee and below the knee, they are lined with polyester taffeta. They have an elasticated waist with a drawstring, two open side pockets and back zipper pocket and also featured is a bottom leg zipper to allow pants to be pulled over shoes.

The jacket will be maroon in colour with a white splice and stripe with the school crest embroidered on the left hand side. The pants are also plain maroon in colour.

The new tracksuit will have a two year phase in period, however, families with children enrolled in the Pre-Primary class in 2018, will be required to purchase the new style of tracksuit along with any new families that start in February 2018. We aim to have all children wearing the new tracksuit by 2020.
