## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND RELIEF TEACHERS

Professional Development offers a range of opportunities for Staff in our school to enhance their knowledge, skills and abilities and in turn, keep abreast of recent developments. All of the Professional Development that staff members attend in turn benefits the children at Santa Clara School. When teachers attend Professional Development sessions, they always leave planned work from their programmes for the relief teacher. The relief teacher follows this work and then communicates with the classroom teacher a summary of the events of the day. We have a regular list of relief teachers whom we employ at our school so they are familiar with routines and practices at the school and are familiar to the children.

#### **SCHOOL ABSENCES**

Please note that a written note explaining ANY and ALL absences from school for your child(ren) must be handed to your child's teacher on their return to school. It is a legal requirement that we keep a signed letter explaining all absences, on file.

#### Helping around the house

Even the youngest child can be allocated a job and be expected to carry it out reliably and well. Good habits learnt early make life better for children at home, at school and in life.


