### Bookings and Cancellations

All children must be enrolled into Santa Clara Out of School Hours Care prior to booking into Vacation Care. Please make your booking requests through the XAP app as soon as possible. Bookings are subject to availability, please ensure you receive a confirmation of booking before dropping your child to our Centre. Some days including Excursions will fill up quicker and have strict booking limits. Cancellations must be made within 7 days notice of the booked date or you will still be charged.

## Friendly Reminders for Vacation Care

**April 2024**

**Hats** – Please ensure your child brings a hat with them to Vacation Care. Hats must be wide brimmed; no caps please. Due to hygiene reasons, we will not be lending any spare hats, therefore if your child does not have a hat their outdoor play will be restricted to the undercover area only.

**Sunscreen**—As part of our Sun Safe Policy children will be required to wear sunscreen before participating in outdoor play. To assist in this we ask that you kindly encourage your child to put on sunscreen upon arrival to the service. We provide a range of different sunscreens by the sign in desk. If you would like to provide your own sunscreen please label it and let staff know.

**Shoes** – Fully enclosed shoes must be worn at all times, no sandals or thongs please.

**Meals** – **REMINDER WE ARE NOT FREE!!** Meals are not included during Vacation Care unless specified on the program. We encourage children to eat at regular intervals, however mealtimes are free-flow and children can eat at their own leisure. Please pack enough food to last, busy days means hungry bellies.

**Drop-off/Collection** – Please ensure that any person coming to the Centre to Drop-off or collect your child is in your enrolment as an authorised person/nominee. These can be added by logging into your XAP app. Each person must use their own details for sign-in and out. **For the safety of your child, we will not be releasing them to anyone who is not registered.**

**Excursions** – Please ensure you are aware of departure times for excursions and drop your child to the service a minimum of half hour prior to departure to ensure they can participate in the safety briefing and get changed into their excursion shirts.

**Activities** – Each day we provide endless opportunities for children to participate in free play. We utilise the indoor & outdoor areas, and provide a range of card & board games, construction resources, craft activities, role-play zones that are constantly accessible. We also have a rest/calm area for quiet play and/or naps. The activities and experiences listed on the program for each day are provided as an additional activity for children who wish to participate.

**Electronics and Toys** – To avoid the disappointment when things go missing or break, please do not allow your child to bring electronics or toys from home\*. If we see your child with items from home we will place them aside until pick-up.

**\*Claymation Day**— Children may bring an iPad for filming during Claymation day. The devices will be put aside until they are needed for this activity only.

**Payments**—Payments must be made in full on a weekly basis via Direct Debit. Failure to follow this policy may result in the cancelation of bookings until payment arrangements can be met.
